

  - Adults
  - Children (1 year to 3 years)
- Where?
  - Medical clinics, laboratories, hospitals
  - Certified Pediatric Phlebotomist
- What?
  - Blood


# Collection Tubes



# 36 Month Collection

- What?
  - Draw order
  - Needle type
  - Adults: 4-6 blood tubes
  - Children: 4-5 blood tubes
  - Tube volumes vary

# Continuing the Conversation

- Logistics
  - Days / hours
  - Requisition Forms / Registration
  - Centrifugation
  - No testing
- Follow-up

# Common Concerns

- Age of participants
- How to register the participant
- Participant confidentiality
- Space
- Payment for blood draws

- Current patient load was too great
- Nationwide laboratories / draw stations
  - Testing of the blood
  - Chain of ownership
- No responses
- Official agreements
- Participants consent
  - Travel reimbursement

- Long, time-consuming process
- ‘Partnership’
- Agreement template
